

**REGULATION OF THE
PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL OF MINISTERS**

of 12 April 2001

**on the dues payable on motions for instituting antimonopoly proceedings
and the mode of their payment.**

(Journal of Laws of 20 April 2001)

Pursuant to article 77 (6) of the Act of 15 December 2000 on Competition and Consumer Protection (Journal of Laws, No. 122, item 1319), it is ordered as follows:

§ 1. Motions for instituting antimonopoly proceedings before the President of the Office of Competition and Consumer Protection shall be subject to the following dues payable by entrepreneurs and associations thereof:

- 1) PLN 500 on the motion concerning competition restricting practices,
- 2) PLN 1,000 on the notification of the intention of concentration of entrepreneurs.

§ 2. The dues referred to in §1 above payable by the entrepreneur or association thereof shall be paid in cash at the pay-desk or to the bank account of the competent tax office with jurisdiction over their registered offices.

§ 3. The entrepreneur or association thereof filing the motion for instituting antimonopoly proceedings shall attach to the motion a receipt evidencing payment of the dues referred to in § 1.

§ 4. The Regulation shall enter into force upon 14 days following its publication.
