- Natural Persons
- National Equivalent of Art. 101
- Remuneration upon finding an infringement
 - 1% of all fines imposed for the infringement
 - 1000 EUR < x < 100 000 EUR
- Confidentiality
- Not part of a leniency application by a company

In our view EU competition rules (Art. 101 and 102 TFEU) are effectively enforced by the Competition Council of the Republic of Lithuania – according to the Law on Competition, the Competition Council has all the necessary enforcement powers (full institutional independence, ability to prioritize the cases, all necessary investigative and enforcement toolbox and ability to impose sanctions, leniency programme etc.). Therefore we do not see the need for any EU action for enhancing the enforcement of EU competition rules and we think that national legislation is enough to ensure the independence of the competition authority.

- Scope of the power to **summon to interviews** expanded to all persons
- Commitments a discretion for the NCA
- Structural remedies in cases of breach of Eq. of Art. 101 and 102 TFEU
- New sanctions
 - detailed list of obstruction of the investigative actions
 - misleading information
 - breach of interim measures or committments
 - 10% direct effect on competition / 1% effect on the investigation
 - additional periodical penalty payments
